Free Training for Audit Certification

Program Details

The Arizona Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Consultation and Training (ACT), is offering a USDA Good Handling Practices/Good Agricultural Practices Training Program for all Arizona specialty crop producers within the state.

GAP certification is a voluntary USDA Federal-State Audit Program that verifies on farm practices that minimize microbial contamination in the production of fresh fruits, vegetables and tree nuts.

GHP certification is also a voluntary USDA audit program verifying compliance within the packing and storage facility, traceback and transport of fresh vegetables, fruits and tree nuts.

Cost: The training programs are free.
Commodities: Fruits, fresh vegetables, nuts and other horticultural foods
ADA/USDA Reimbursement Program: ADA will reimbursement up to 75% for one annual successful audit for GAP and/or GHP certification
Length of Course: 1 day
USDA Certification: 80% of an audited section
